

RECITAL INFORMATION 2015 DATES & TIMES

The recital will be held at:

Friday, June 12th at 6:30p.m.

Saturday, June 13th at 4p.m.

Students need to **arrive 45 minutes** prior to showtime.

Doors will open at **45-60 minutes** before showtime.

TICKET/WRISTBAND INFORMATION

Ticket/wristbands will be handed out starting **May 26th**

Ticket/wristbands can not be switched for either night.

Tuition must be paid in full to receive tickets/wristbands.

Pink Wristbands are for Friday's show

Teal Wristbands are for Saturday's show

Dancers without wristbands will be able to enter into to the school and dressing area but not the auditorium.

If you forget your wristbands we will **not** be able to let you in. Please make sure you have your wristbands on when you arrive.

EXTRA TICKETS

If you have already emailed me your extra ticket request please send in payment this week. I still have extra tickets available for both shows.

Please email me asap if you need additional tickets.

RECITAL T-SHIRTS

T-shirts will arrive June 1st. All students will participate in the finale and must wear a recital t-shirt, jean shorts, & white canvas/leather sneakers(as much white as possible).

SHOES/TIGHTS/COSTUMES

Everyone should have their shoes, tights and costumes at this point.

Students should have black tap shoes with black ribbon or laces and pink ballet shoes.

JUNE TUITION

All tuition must be paid no later than June 5th. Tuition is a yearly fee broken up into 10 payments.

RECITAL VIDEO

Gary Antle Productions will be providing DVD's for the recital. DVD'S are \$40.00. Please fill out the video form and hand in by June 10th. All checks for DVD's must be made out to GARY ANTLE PRODUCTIONS. Forms are due June 10th. You may also order online at garyantleproductions.com

DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress rehearsal will be held on Wednesday, June 10th at 5:00p.m. at Pioneer Valley Regional School. All students need to be dressed and ready to go on stage at 5:00p.m. Students need to be in full costumes. If your child needs a hem or a tuck please have it done for dress rehearsal. Older students that need undergarments please make sure you have them on. Hair needs to be done, make up, tights and shoes.

Dress rehearsal last about 2-3 hours. We start with the finale (no finale costume) and then run in order of the show. Students may leave as soon as their dances are done. A recital program shall be handed out prior to dress rehearsal so students know what costume to wear first.

STUDENT SUPERVISION

All students must have one parent with them at dress rehearsal and both shows. Please do not drop off your child without adult supervision.

HAIR AND MAKE-UP

All students must have their hair in a french braid or bun. **NO PONYTAILS.** The best way to do a bun is to wet and gel the hair then pull into a pony tail and braid it. Take the hair and wrap it around to make a bun. Secure with bobby pins and a hair net. Hair nets are mandatory with a bun. Students with very short hair will need to pull their bangs and sides back with a barrette. Students must wear eye make-up, blush, and lipstick/tinted lip gloss.

DRESSING ROOMS

Female parents/guardians will be allowed in the dressing area at anytime. Dads and boy dancers will not be allowed. All boy dancers should arrive at the high school in their costume and have a ticket to the show. If there is a conflict with this please let me know.

STAGE INFORMATION

Please bring your child back stage 3 numbers before their dances. The stage manager will take over from there. Sit and Enjoy!

LITTLE ONE INSTRUCTIONS

All Minnie and Mickey mouse dancers will need to be brought backstage at the beginning of the show and after intermission. Most dances have been choreographed to enter on and exit off stage with their music. When their routines are over we will bring them right into the dressing area. Please come get them as soon as their dance is over.

SEATS

People are asked not to get up during a dance routine. People should wait until each routine is finished. We will do our best to make sure this happens.

NEW VENUE

This will be my first time at Pioneer Valley Regional School. I will do my best to make sure things go as smoothly as possible but I do have a feeling that we will need to iron out a few kinks. Dress rehearsal will most likely take a little extra time so please bare with us while we figure everything out. Pizazz is celebrating 20 years and I am confident that this recital will be special!
