Ms. Caitlin



In July 2015 Caitlin's dreams came true when she bought Pizazz Dance Studio. Now as a studio owner/director Caitlin thrives on making all dancers who walk through her doors fall in love with art of dance while building confidence and having fun. She is very thankful for her amazing

Becky Reade has been dancing for 44 years , studying Tap, Ballet, Jazz, Lyrical, Pointe and Gymnastics. She began at the age of 3 at Carol Butlers School of Dance in



Northampton, Ma. At 11 years old she continued her dance education with Gerrianne Genga Dance and Gymnastics in Warwick , R.I. Becky has competed in numerous dance competitions and attended many conventions throughout New England. She has been teaching dance for 28 years and is experienced in various ages and levels . Ms. Christina

Christina Bardwell is a native of western Massachusetts where she grew up studying all areas of dance at Hackworth School of performing arts. She's been dancing for the past

36 years and fell in love with the rhythms and sounds of tap dancing. Christina trained with some of the most prestigious tap teachers including Mike Minnery, Gil Stroming, Michelle Dorance, Derek Grant, Jimmy Slide, Harold Nicholas and most importantly her mentor Lisa Heath. Christina won numerous dance titles as her career progressed in the competition circuit. In 2000 after qualifying, she joined the JR USA tap team. Christina and her duo partner Kim traveled to Slovenia and won the JR tap duo World Champion title. In 2002 she qualified on the SR USA tap team traveling to Germany. Here she competed against 50 other nations in the 16 and over age category. She won two gold medals receiving her most awarded title of SR world tap duo champion and SR tap solo champion. She is the first female solo winner to receive a perfect score at the world championship competition. Christina performed in a off Broadway tap show Break the Floor and has performed at numerous events. Christina has since



turned her love and gift of dance into an opportunity for others to learn. She has been teaching all styles of dance for 20 years taking pleasure in every step along the way.

Ms. Nicky

Nicky Phillips has been dancing for over 30 years. She studied Tap, Ballet/Point, Lyrical, Modern & Jazz competitively for the highly regarded KDS Dance Company until her



graduation from High School in 2005. She also was in numerous Ja'Duke productions/musicals in the summers throughout high school and college. In college she danced for the Worcester State Dance Company and then eventually a D1 Dance team for the University of Hartford. Although, she has taken a break from the dance scene since becoming a Mom in 2013, her love for it has never wavered.
